Paris Charlety – Competition Venue Certified IAAF + Warm-up Track

**Training Venue:** Paris - Louis Lumière Stadium direct access from the Residence International de Paris (Official Event Hotel)

Training Facilities: Track; Jump and Throw (shot put) areas

### **Registration Forms**

- Sports Registration (SDMS) must be done online from March 14<sup>th</sup> 2018 to May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018. NPC's must enter athletes and guides through the Online Entry System (SDMS).
- To get 20% discount, the registration form in the appendix must be send before April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018 (Package 1). Otherwise it needs to be send on May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at the latest. (Accommodation / Transport / Catering / Other Services)

## **#Your Stay in Paris**

### Transport

NPCs are responsible for their own athletes, guide-runners and any other staff members. The Local Organising Committee will take care of ground transfer – persons and equipment – from Paris Train Stations (only) to the Residence International de Paris (LOC's headquarters and Official Event Hotel).

The LOC offers a shuttle option for an extra fee, from Paris' airports to hotels and competition venue.

**Public Transportation Ticket:** A Paris Visit Pass will be given to you by LOC upon your arrival. This pass will allow you to enjoy unrestricted and unlimited travels within Paris using bus, subway, tram lines.

The LOC will not organize transportation from the official event hotel to the competition venue. The Charléty Stadium is easily reachable by everyone using public transportation (30 -35 minutes; Tram line T3a / Stop: Stade Charléty). The LOC offers a transfer option for an extra fee, between the official event hotel and the competition venue.

Athletes' Equipment: During the competition  $(14^{th} - 15^{th} June)$ , the LOC offers an on-demand equipment's transportation service from the official event hotel to the competition venue.

# **#Sports Information**

### Sports registration

Registrations are open to all Athletes licensed by World Para Athletics for the year 2018

Sports registrations are open from March 14th 2018 until May, 14th 2018.

Registrations fees are included within the 2 packages offered.

Without any package booking offered by the LOC, sports registration rights' fee is set to 100€ per athlete, who can participate up to 5 events.

### **Competition Regulations**

World Para Athletics Rules and Regulations (Technical and Classification) current at the date of the event, that will be used.

International Technical Officials: Tarek SOUEI (UAE), Technical Delegate and Halim JEBALI (TUN), Chief Classifier.

### **Competition Schedule**

The final competition schedule will be confirmed, after the sports' registration closing. The preliminary competition schedule is attached.

### **Technical Meeting**

The technical meeting is scheduled at the eve of the competition at the Charlety Stadium: Wednesday, June 13th (time to be confirmed). The NPC/NF representative's attendance is mandatory. Prior to the technical meeting, NPC/NF will receive a final confirmation form to make final changes. Bibs will be distributed per NPC/NF at the end of the technical meeting, and entries will be considered as final. If an athlete does not participate in one of his/her events, he/she will immediately be disqualified for the rest of the competition. Start-lists will be produced after the technical meeting and displayed/distributed at the Competition Stadium.

### Medals Ceremonies

Medals will be given to the first three Winner of each event. Rankings will be based on the World Para Athletics' Points Score System. Competition format and procedures will be explained during the technical meeting.



## **#Classification**

An international classification for athletes with New or Review status will be conducted prior to the competition. Concerning visual and physical impairment's classifications, more information will soon be communicated.

## **#Medical Services**

In addition to emergency services in case of incidents, a medical and paramedical space will be available on the warm-up field during the competition.

Your team will have the opportunity to benefit from sport specific advices along with medical and physiotherapy treatments adapted to disabled athletes. If these athletes have well-known problems, it is possible to come with medical files.

If you plan to come with a doctor and/or a team physiotherapist, we strongly suggest you that these latter contact Frédéric RUSAKIEWICZ. You will be able to share the common space with our team and exchange together.

A physiotherapy and first aid services will be present on the competition stadium.

## **#Anti-doping**

Controls will be conducted according to AFLD's (French Agency Doping Controls) anti-doping controls procedures.

## **#Accreditations**

Athletes/staff's accreditations will be given prior to the classification or during the first day of competition, at the Official Event Hotel. The LOC will deliver accreditations to NPCs that have settled their registration's fee (sports registration rights are included in package 1 or 2).

### Warning: No accreditation delivery on the competition venue!

For obvious security purposes, every Stadium's accesses will be controlled. It will be required from athletes, guide-runners and staff members to carry on their accreditation at all time, on all official sites (including hotels).

The accreditation is personal and can't be handed over to another person at risk of an irrevocable withdrawal of it. An accreditation loss must immediately be reported to the LOC. The athlete or any other person will be charged 20€ to cover new production technical fee.
