their entries made, will be deleted from the entry list.

\*5.000m only offered for Tokyo eligible classes T53/54 for wheelchair races and T11/12/13 for ambulant athletes, but both men and women

There is a fixed fee of 50 € per athlete. For the payment entry fees you

will receive an official invoice with a payment deadline and reference

number. Bank details will be listed in the invoice.

The entry fee has to be paid by bank transfer until the payment deadline given in the invoice. Only athletes the entry fee has been paid for, will be on the start lists. Entries that are not paid for till the payment deadline

will not be accepted for the competition.

### **Important Notices**

#### **Technical Meeting**

We will hold a technical meeting on Friday, June 29<sup>th</sup> at 18:00h in the Jahnstadion (please see signs). Prior to the technical meeting you will receive a final confirmation list, where you can make final changes. After this time, all entries are fixed. If an athlete does not participate, he/she will be also disqualified for all subsequent following events. Start lists will be produced after the closing time and published at the venue and at <a href="https://www.grandprixathletics.berlin">www.grandprixathletics.berlin</a>.

#### "Did not start"

An athlete, who doesn't start in a competition without being withdrawn, will be disqualified for this competition and all following events.

#### **Competition regulations**

The Grand Prix 2018 will be held under the following regulations:

- If 5 male or female athletes of one start class are present, there will be a single class resulting, if less athletes are present classes will be combined; a point system may be used
- The final event programme and class combination shall be determined along with the Technical Delegate after close of the final entry.
- Standing and sitting classes will not be combined

#### **Victory ceremonies**

There will be some ceremonies per day in the main stadium. Please check the victory ceremony schedule. For those participating in the victory ceremonies please be at the Call Room at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled time from here you will be guided to the victory ceremony area.

All other medals and diplomas can be picked up by the delegation leader at the competition office.

#### **Bib Numbers**

Athletes must have their numbers on the front side of their shirt, except for high jump competitors. Wheelchair racers should have their number on the back of their chair. Seated throwers should have a second number on the throwing frame. Safety pins will not be provided and must be brought by the teams.

#### Own equipment

Own equipment can be used but must be inspected prior to competing. Inspection of this equipment must be completed no less than 2 hours prior to the event in which it is being used. Equipment inspection is the responsibility of the individual. Equipment can be inspected at the checkpoint (white container) next to the last call area.

#### **Competition Schedule**

The attached schedule is only provisional. We will check and correct the schedule as soon as possible, but there may also be late changes. Please listen to the announcer and/or check the papers on the information wall.

#### **Detailed venue information**

Details concerning the final competition venue will be shown on the start list. Maps showing the competition sites will be available at the venue.

#### **Track events**

For the 100m and 200m there will be heats <u>and</u> finals, all other track events will be time heats.

For wheelchair track events (classes T31-34 and T51-54) a helmet must be worn.

#### Warm up

The warm up is only permitted in the warm up stadium. Please be aware that competitions may also take place in the warm up stadium.

#### **Call Room**

Entrance to the field of play is only permitted via call room, please check the call room information. Athletes who are not in the Call Room at the given time prior to their competition cannot start in that event.

#### **Call Room times:**

Track: 25 min
Throw / Jump: 35 min

Set out above is the minimum time prior to the competition time athletes should arrive at the call room. Athletes should arrive 25/35 minutes prior to their stated start time.

#### Accreditation

For all athletes the start number attached at the shirt or wheelchair is valid as an accreditation to gain access to the last call area from where they will be guided to the competition sites.

Accompanying staff and coaches are not allowed to enter the field of play.

In accordance with World Para Athletics Rule 7 (Assistance to Athletes), Athletes with the starting classes T/F11 and 12 as well as F 31-33 and F 51-54 are permitted to bring an assistant to the call room. The assistant will be given an assistant/guide vest to enter the stadium together with the athlete. There will be a deposit needed to get the vest (One of the following must be provided as a deposit: ID card, passport, driver's license or 10€).

For athletes outside of these classes, a request for assistance must be made to the Technical Delegate. Please apply for exceptions for assistance with the application form that can be found below. Please send the application no later than one week prior to the competition.

Any violation of this rule will be punished by the disqualification of the athlete.

#### Please note: The competition time table might be changed after the final entry!

#### Classification

The event is open for all impairment types recognised by World Para Athletics. International PI and VI classification will be offered. Classification dates are June 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> 2018.

Athletes must be registered with World Para Athletics in order to undergo classification. Priority will be given to licensed athletes, and then registered athletes.

All teams should be aware that all athletes with a N (new) or R (review) status on the World Para Athletics Classification Master list will be required to attend classification. Please plan your arrival in Berlin accordingly. The timetable for classification will be made by World Para Athletics after the final entry. The organiser of the Grand Prix has no influence on the timetable or has the ability to make any changes. World Para Athletics cannot guarantee classification for athletes entered after the entry deadline.

#### **Anti-Doping**

The regulations of the Deutscher Behindertensportverband e.V. (German Disabled Sports Federation DBS-NPC) clearly outlaw any type of doping. The Anti-Doping Code of the DBS applies in conjunction with the regulations of WADA, the IPC, the NADA and — at international competitions — the regulations of the international host federation.

By submitting his or her application as a participant, the athlete acknowledges and accepts the anti-doping regulations in their currently valid version (available online under <a href="http://www.paralympic.org/athletics/anti-doping/documents">http://www.paralympic.org/athletics/anti-doping/documents</a>).

Athletes are not allowed to take or carry with them any substances that are included on the WADA Prohibited List. Athletes who are found to have violated this rule shall be held individually responsible for their action.

Athletes who are taking medication from the (most recent) WADA Prohibited List for therapeutic reasons will need a copy of their Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) for any generally prohibited substance.
