

NPCs Competing at the Dubai 2019 World Para Athletics Championships

Final Medal Event Programme and Qualification Rounds

Dear NPCs,

World Para Athletics (WPA) are pleased to confirm that <u>all</u> events on the Event Programme of the Dubai 2019 World Para Athletics Championships meet the Event Viability Criteria of a minimum five (5) athlete entries from three (3) NPCs for these Championships. There are therefore no changes to the Medal Event Programme.

Competition Schedule Updates

As we received an unprecedented high number of entries, as a result, a number of additional Rounds and Heats will be added to the schedule. In an effort to keep all finals in the planned sessions as published in version 1.0 of the competition schedule, the following measures have to be introduced in accordance with the qualification guide:

Qualification Rounds for Throwing Events

As previously anticipated, Qualification Rounds for a number of throwing events are necessary to enable the final to be conducted within the allocated timeframe of the respective competition session, also taking into consideration the weather condition in Dubai and the athletes wellbeing. Qualification Rounds will be held for all seated throwing events exceeding twelve (12) entries and all ambulant throwing events exceeding sixteen (16) entries.

A total of twelve (12) Qualification Rounds will be held in Dubai. Nine (9) Qualification Rounds will be held in additional morning sessions on Thursday 07 November and Friday 08 November. Three (3) more qualification rounds will be held during the originally scoped competition sessions on Saturday 09 November or Sunday 10 November, as follows:

For seated throw events with more than 12 entries, the top 8 entered athletes from the Qualification Ranking shall proceed to the final without competing in the qualification round. The Top 4 athletes from the qualification round shall proceed to the final. Athletes will have a maximum of three trials in the qualification round.

For ambulant throwing events with more than 16 entries, the top 12 entered athletes from the Qualification Ranking shall proceed to the final without competing in the qualification round. The top 4 athletes from the qualification round shall proceed to the final. Athletes will have a maximum of three trials in the qualification round.

Heats and Additional Rounds for Track Events

In 1500m and 5000m events where the entries fall slightly outside of the tables presented under Rule 21 (Seedings, Draws and Qualification Events), the Technical Delegates have taken the decision to conduct these events in one single round. This decision was taken in the best interests of the athletes, taking into consideration the multiple number of events those athletes will be competing in and the weather conditions in Dubai.



Finally, to avoid unintended adverse consequence by moving finals to a different session and minimise disruptions to athletes' preparation, the following additional rounds will be held on the morning of Thursday 07 November:
